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

A combination of stories - my dad nicknamed me "Johnny Awful", my mother protected my brother, and I used my sister's finger to pick my nose.




I was carrying my clothes in an orange crate when a stranger approached me with a \$1. I decided not to explain to him that we weren't broke.

My nephew's lost dog could have been anywhere within a 10 mile radius. It only took me 5 minutes to find him.




Me enjoying the spotlight for finding the dog. My nephew knew there would be no living with me.




I found Stan Butler at the CPA awards banquet. He was not happy to see that I had passed, since I only put in a minimal amount of studying.




I'm in general parking with everyone else, while Archibald shows off his Rolls Royce.

The Bowling Green branch building house ramps for a young boy who was paralyzed in a car accident.






Staying at a drug infested, rent-by-the-hour hotel, just to save \$20. From that day forward, my goal was not to die an idiot.


